Survey for volunteers in Sporting Events


- The survey was distributed from March 1st to July 1st 2020 in seven countries (Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Italy, Poland, Sweden and Turkey)
- 402 participants answered the survey
- 57% female participants
- 81% of participants had volunteered at a sporting event

Participants per country






HOW OLD ARE YOU?








How old are you? Country specific break-down






HOW DID YOU GET INVOLVED IN VOLUNTEERING?






How did you get involved in volunteering? Country specific









Concluding Remarks Volunteer Survey

- Over 400 answers (≥50 per country)
- A lot of similarities between the different countries
- About 50% of the volunteers had received non-formal education but almost all got clear instructions prior to the event
- The volunteers generally feels that their work is appreciated
- Finally, volunteers indicate that they would benefit from more nonformal education and that the vast majority are interested in participating in such education





Survey for Sports Clubs


- The survey was distributed from March 1st to July 1st 2020 in seven countries (Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Italy, Poland, Sweden and Turkey)
- 208 representatives for sports clubs answered the survey
- 84% of participating sports clubs organized sporting events
 - 50% 1-3 events per year
 - 25 % 4-6 events per year
 - 25 % 7 or more events per year
- 91 % of the event organizing sports clubs involved volunteers in their events






COUNTRIES

Participants per country






DO YOU HAVE **A VOLUNTEER DATABASE?**











Concluding Remarks Sports Club Survey

- Over 200 answers (>20 per country)
- A lot of similarities between the different countries
- A majority of sports clubs (60%) offer volunteer training but 73% want to offer additional training/education to the volunteers
- The most frequent means of recruiting volunteers are from the own organization and through advertisement in social media
- Finally, almost all sports clubs (89%) are interested in participating in a volunteer education project
